

To our Preston Feather Team,

By now many of you know Governor Whitmer has announced an executive order for residents of non-essential businesses to stay-at-home, effective midnight tonight (Monday). The order is effective for 3 weeks. This is longer than most anticipated.

The order has just been published, and we need to review it and consult with the State on how Preston Feather, its customers and suppliers have been classified (essential? Non-essential?). There is not firm guidance on the definition.

We do know that some of our key suppliers have been notifying us (Amerhart, Azek/Timbertech, etc) that they have been deemed “essential businesses” in states that have stay-at-home orders. This precedent may influence Michigan and how they classify contractors, building materials suppliers and our supply chain partners. On a federal level, building and construction is considered a component of national defense and emergency response.

I will provide an update of what we know at 3pm and again this evening (by email and on our web site Employee Gateway at <https://prestonfeather.com/employee/>)

We will not compromise the safety of any of our staff as we adapt. If our contractor customers, Preston Feather and our suppliers are deemed an essential businesses, and we can remain open safely, we will do so.
