After Governor Whitmer's stay-at-home order announcement at 11:00, many of our customers are calling to ask if we are still open.

Please advise customers that we are waiting for guidance from the State of Michigan on if our business is considered essential or non-essential. Some other states with stay-at-home orders have determined lumber yards/building materials centers and related suppliers are essential. We also have some vendors in our supply chain experience some disruptions, so it is too early to tell how much we will be affected. We do know that Northern Lumber in Traverse City and Lumbermens (our largest supplier) plan to be remain open based on their interpretation of the Governor's order. But we need to do more homework.

Contractors also want to know if they are "essential businesses". We will find out more soon and share more with our customers on this topic, too.
