COMMON QUESTIONS

What is Timbertech decking made of?

Timbertech is made of up of three distinct lines:
Timbertech Azek: Capped polymer decking
Timbertech Pro: 4-sided capped composite decking
Timbertech Edge: 3-sided capped composite decking

Is Timbertech decking maintenance free?

Less maintenance is required than traditional wood decks, but there is still cleaning and care involved. Use only recommended cleaning products.

How durable is Timbertech?

The deck boards are fairly strong, but caution is required not to scratch them with heavy sharp items. Petroleum-based products (sunscreen, certain rugs, and more) and grill grease can stain the surfaces and require care.

Is it worth it to spend the extra money?

In the long run, yes. Choosing Timbertech can increase property values and save money on maintenance over the life of the deck. Non-wood boards also last longer than wood, thus extending the life of your deck surface.

What color options are there?

INSTALLATION QUESTIONS

How can I fasten the deck boards to the framing?

There are a few options; use grooved boards with clips between them, square edge boards with surface screws or a jig for side screw entry. Review warranty information before deciding on a fastener style.

How far can I span between deck joists?

Typically 12"-16" between joists. There are some instances that it may change depending of patterned layouts. In this case please contact your rep for further advice.

SIZING

Stock deck boards are sold as 5/4" thick, 6" wide, and 16' and 20' lengths. Additional lengths and widths may be available via special order.
